

CLEAN ENERGY TAX INCENTIVES FOR MARYLAND RESIDENTS

STATE INCENTIVES

Maryland Excise Tax Credit for Plug-in Electric Vehicles



Subject to available funding, a credit is allowed for the purchase of a zero-emission plug-in electric or fuel cell electric vehicle. The credit may not exceed **\$3,000**.

Residential Clean Energy Rebates



Rebates for solar photovoltaic systems, solar water heating, and geothermal heating & cooling systems.

Maryland Solar Access Program (available beginning 2025)



For eligible Maryland residents to assist with the cost of installing solar photovoltaic (PV) systems to power their homes with sustainable energy.

FEDERAL INCENTIVES

Tax Credits for Clean Vehicles - New Electric Vehicles (EVs)



You may qualify for a credit up to **\$7,500** under Internal Revenue Code Section 30D if you buy a new, qualified plug-in electric vehicle.

Tax Credits for Clean Vehicles - Used Electric Vehicles (EVs)



If you buy a qualified used EV from a licensed dealer for \$25,000 or less, you may be eligible for a used clean vehicle tax credit. The credit equals **30%** of the sale price up to a maximum credit of **\$4,000**.

Residential Clean Energy Credit



The Residential Clean Energy Credit equals **30%** of the costs of new, qualified clean energy property for your home installed anytime from 2022 through 2032. You can claim the annual credit every year that you install eligible property until 2033.

Examples include:

- Solar electric panels
- Solar water heaters
- Geothermal heat pumps
