Comptroller Lierman Joins Leaders to Urge Marylanders to Sign Up for Health Insurance During Tax Season

WHAT: Comptroller Lierman will gather with Maryland officials and advocates Friday morning for a press conference to highlight the state's Easy Enrollment Health Insurance Program, which allows Maryland residents to begin the process of signing up for affordable health insurance by checking a box on their state tax returns.

In 2019, Maryland became the first state in the nation to establish a tax-based Easy Enrollment program. Since the program was formally launched, more than 100,000 Marylanders have checked the box on their state tax return to learn more, and more than 10,000 have signed up for affordable health insurance. The program is a key

part of the state's strategy to connect more Marylanders to health insurance, with a goal of getting all state residents covered for care.
