Office of the Comptroller Completes Relocation of Baltimore Office to Downtown Baltimore

300 employees reporting to newly renovated spaces inside the former Wells Fargo Tower

ANNAPOLIS, Md. (June 11, 2024) — The Maryland Office of the Comptroller has completed its move from the State Center complex in Baltimore to the newly renovated office space at 7 Saint Paul Street in Downtown Baltimore. The 67,000-square-foot office modern office spaces spans several floors and will be occupied by more than 300 employees.

“I am proud that our agency led the way in this relocation and is making a meaningful investment in the future of Downtown Baltimore,” **Comptroller Brooke E. Lierman** said. “I appreciate the hard work and commitment of our staff, and the Department of General Services to ensure a smooth transition for our team and our customers alike.”

The first phase of the agency's move to Downtown Baltimore was completed in January, with a [ribbon cutting](#) celebrating the relocation of the Taxpayer Services Division's Baltimore branch office. With the completion of phase two, Compliance, Hearings and Appeals, Unclaimed Property, and Assistant Attorneys General Divisions are now operating out of the office at 7 Saint Paul Street.

The new office space offers a modern and collaborative working environment for staff, updated facilities to serve customers, and is highly accessible by public transit and walkable from other locations downtown. The new Baltimore City branch office is conveniently located near the Charles Center Metro Station, with a dedicated entrance at Saint Paul and Baltimore streets for taxpayers seeking in-person services.
