One Million Business Tax Returns Processed through Maryland Tax Connect

Maryland Office of the Comptroller marks milestone 9 months after launch

ANNAPOLIS, Md. (November 14, 2024) — Comptroller Brooke E. Lierman today announced that the Office of the Comptroller has processed more than 1 million business-related tax returns through the agency’s new online portal, [Maryland Tax Connect](#). The secure self-service platform, which launched in February, allows business users, including distributors and wholesalers [in the alcohol industry](#), to file and pay their taxes electronically. So far, 149,222 users have registered for accounts with Maryland Tax Connect.

“Maryland Tax Connect helps to simplify and streamline the tax filing process for businesses, while also providing a new level of transparency,” **Comptroller Lierman** said. “We are committed to using new technology to transform the way we serve and support the needs of Marylanders, and we appreciate the help of our users in making the platform better.”

Maryland Tax Connect is available on desktop and mobile devices and, in addition to tax filing and payment, allows businesses to:

- Retrieve tax information
- Update personal information
- View filing and tax history
- Register a business
- Apply for or renew business licenses
- Apply for sales and use tax exemptions
